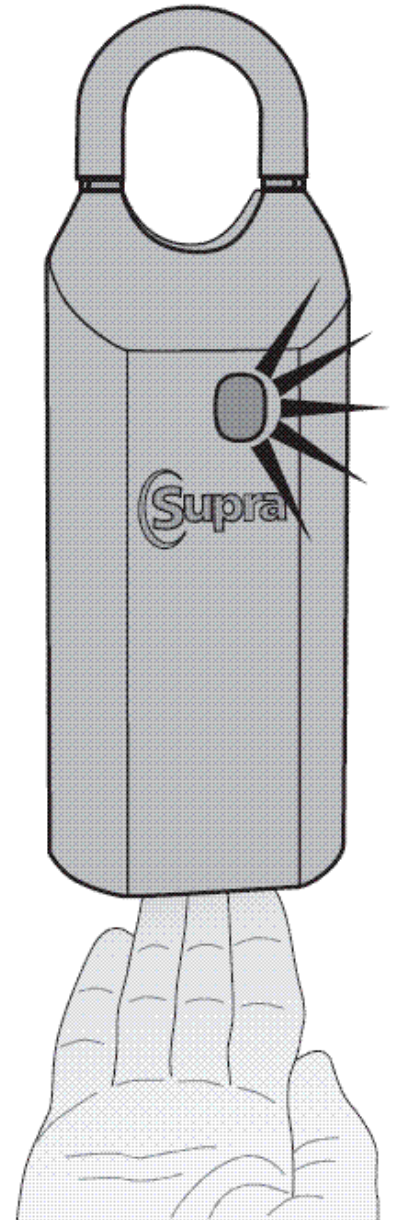


Obtaining the key container in a Bluetooth iBox with your Android or BlackBerry Smartphone

1. **Start the operation by opening the eKEY app on your smartphone.**
2. Select **Obtain Key** and enter your 4 digit pin code and tap **Begin**.
3. **Press up** on the bottom of the key container of the Bluetooth iBox to **turn on the Bluetooth** in the box.
4. A **red light** on the Bluetooth iBox flashes letting you know Bluetooth is on and ready.
5. **If prompted** for a password, enter **0000**
6. Your screen will display **Success** and you can press up on the key container to obtain the key.



*Blackberry Users

After communicating with a Bluetooth iBox (above), you are prompted to delete the Bluetooth pairing entry.

1. Select **Bluetooth List**
2. Select **Supra RE Keybox** from your list of Bluetooth paired devices.
3. Select **Delete Device**
4. Select **OK**

Press the round, back arrow button on your Blackberry to return to the eKEY application.
